### Clarification of Rule L6(b): This rule has been clarified to read as follows:

Automatic qualification to register as a UK player will apply to any player holding a Full British/UK Citizens Passport. Other players will qualify if they meet one of the following criteria:-

- 1) Holds a Birth Certificate stating his place of Birth is within the UK,
- 2) Has a mother or father born within the UK and the player has been a resident of the UK for the preceding 12 months.
- 3) Be aged 15 years or under and has been permanently resident in the UK for the preceding 12 months.
- Has been permanently resident in the UK for at least the preceding 2 years and holds documentary evidence from the British 4) Government that they may remain in the UK for a minimum of 3 consecutive years calculated from the date of entry into the UK.

Note a): "Permanent resident" is defined as not being absent from the UK for more than 35 days in any 12 month period.

Note b): a person holding only a British Subject, British Dependant, British Overseas Citizen, British National Overseas Citizen or a British Protected Person passport, as opposed to a Full British/UK Citizens Passport, will not qualify by right as a UK player.
