Introduction: The Chairman welcomed everyone to the December 2016 Council meeting.

The Minutes

The minutes of the Council meeting of the 7th September 2016 were taken as read, approved as a true record, and signed.

Matters arising

The Composition of the League see SGM – The Chairman confirmed the 6 elected clubs would be playing 2nd XI cricket next season. He would be inviting them all to meet the Executive in January to go through expected standards of them.

Financial Report

The Finance Secretary advised the meeting the balance sheet was as reported at the AGM. Some clubs still owed money for the League Dinner.

Disciplinary Report

The Administration & Disciplinary Secretary had no disciplinary matters to report. He reminded the meeting about the Umpires questionnaire to be filled in and returned to him by 31st December 2016.

Grounds Report

The Child Welfare & Facilities Secretary reported the new clubs would be visited in the New Year.

Report from the Umpires Association

Ron Tindall reported things were looking better with more club umpires offering to go away with their clubs. However umpires were still needed for the League panel. A Level 1 umpires course been run at Broad Oak in January was full up. The Umpires Association would run an independent course if numbers increased.

League Dinner report

The General Secretary reported 35 clubs had attended with a total of 251 places but 2 clubs hadn't turned up. He welcomed any feedback relating to the dinner.

Report from Match & Registration Secretary

The Match & Registration Secretary reported he had received 4 or 5 registrations already but asked if anymore could be held off until the New Year as he would be busy with the league fixtures. A new version for 2017 had been done and asked if clubs could use this one. It would be available to download from the website. League fixtures would commence Saturday 15th April 2017 and end Saturday 9th September 2017.

The Heavy Woollen cup dates had changed.

The league fixtures would be much more complicated to do this time with the new clubs and larger divisions in 2nd XI cricket but he hoped they would be done by the end of December. Confirmation was given that Championship 2 and Conference 2 would play each team once and 5 others twice giving 22 league fixtures.

The Match & Registration and General Secretary then explained the draws for the All Rounder Sykes Cup, Fired Earth Paddock Shield and Total Indoor Cricket Solutions T20 Shield preliminary and the first rounds would be done by computer software for the first time.
