# GIRLS CRICKET – PATHWAYS TO PLAY

## 1. U11 Girls Introduction Festivals

- **Ball:** Windball
- **Format:** 6-a-side, informal festivals
- **Who for:** Beginners in Years 3–6 (particularly younger U11s or those new to cricket)
- **Style:** Fun, friendly and flexible – perfect first experience
- **Typical structure:** Three short games per team, lasting around 1 hour 30 minutes
- **When:** Usually Monday evenings
- **Organised by:** Steph Bown (Almondbury Wesleyan CC)

These festivals give clubs the chance to bring along players whenever it works for them, with the emphasis firmly on enjoyment and confidence building. Clubs can team up to put together sides, or lend players to give everyone a go.

- **Ball:** Incrediball
- **Format:** 8-a-side pairs
- **Organised by:** West Yorkshire Women & Girls Cricket League

## 3. U13 Hardball League (NEW for 2026)

- **Ball:** 4 ¾ oz junior cricket ball
- **Format:** 8-a-side hardball pairs
- **Overs:** 16 overs per game
- **Surfaces:** Astro pitches permitted with notice
- **Organised by:** West Yorkshire Women & Girls Cricket League
- **Entry:** Complete online form:

#### 4. U15 Hardball League

- **Ball:** 5oz women's cricket ball
- **Format:** T20
- **Team size:** Up to 11-a-side (can be fewer by mutual agreement)
- **Wicket length:** Same as U13 mixed cricket for ease of logistics
- **Surfaces:** Astro pitches permitted with notice
- **Organised by:** West Yorkshire Women & Girls Cricket League
- **Entry:** Complete online form:

- **Facilities:** 19 yards, astro pitches allowed
- **Divisions:** Minimum of 3 divisions per region
- **Experience limits:** Applied in lower divisions to keep cricket safe and inclusive
- **Experienced players:** Welcome to support through fielding and mentoring
- **Organised by:** West Yorkshire Women & Girls Cricket League
- **Entry:** Complete online form:

- **Entry:** Closed for 2026
- **Geography:** Regionalised Fixtures – Kirklees and Calderdale

### 3. Women's Hardball T20 League

- **Format:** 8-a-side T20 (additional players allowed by agreement)
- **Experience limits:** To maintain competitive balance
- **Organised by:** West Yorkshire Women & Girls Cricket League
- **Entry:** Closed for 2026
- **Geography:** Regionalised Fixtures – Kirklees and Calderdale

### 4. Women's Hardball Premier League

- **Format:** Traditional 11-a-side hardball cricket
- **Structure:**
  - Division 1 – 40 overs
  - Division 2 – 30 overs
- **Organised by:** West Yorkshire Women & Girls Cricket League
- **Entry:** Closed for 2026
- **Geography:** All West Yorkshire
