

T30 Specific Rules

- T30.1 START DATE:
The mini season will run from Saturday 18th July to Saturday 12th September inclusive.
- T30.2 START TIME:
All games to start at 1pm.
- T30.3 LENGTH OF INNINGS:
Each team shall bowl a maximum of 30 overs.
- T30.4 NUMBER OF OVERS PER BOWLER:
Each bowler will be limited to a maximum of 1/5 of the overs allowed (6 overs in a full 30 over game).
- T30.5 RESTRICTION ON THE PLACEMENT OF FIELDERS:
There will be a 30 yard fielding zone in place throughout each innings
 - T30.5.1 At the instant of delivery there shall be a minimum of 4 fielders plus bowler and wicketkeeper inside the zone at all time.
 - T30.5.2 At the instant of delivery there shall be no more than 5 Fielders on the leg side in Groups RED; ORANGE; YELLOW & GREEN.
- T30.6 NOMINATION OF PLAYERS:
 - T30.6.1 Clubs (& Umpires) will NOT be expected to complete the TMRF, but the club must ensure that team names are correctly recorded on Play-Cricket before the game.
 - T30.6.2 Clubs will be expected to provide umpires with the names and age group of any players under 19 years of age, to help enforce any ECB fast bowling & fielding restrictions.
 - T30.6.3 Clubs will be expected to collect information of all those in attendance, including Home & Visiting Team players; umpires; scorers and spectators where appropriate. These details should be kept for 21 days to assist with NHS Test and Trace.
- T30.7 LEG SIDE WIDES:
Leg side wides shall be in operation in Groups RED; ORANGE; YELLOW & GREEN only.
- T30.8 MATCH BALLS:
A red ball should be used which need not necessarily be new, but must be of acceptable quality and be a brand and grade normally approved by the Executive.
- T30.9 TEA INTERVAL:
There shall be an interval of not more than 20 minutes – Umpires & Captains to decide at the toss. Clubs shall NOT prepare food for participants.
- T30.10 POINTS:
Points will be awarded as per League rules, including Performance Points.

T30 Specific Rules

- T30.11 ABANDONED, DELAYED OR INTERRUPTED GAMES:

- T30.11.1 Prior to the start of the game:

- If it appears obvious that due to inclement weather, a ground will be unfit for play, the home captain/representative may phone the away captain/representative prior to 10 00am on the day of the match to suggest the game is abandoned. If agreed the game shall be abandoned. If not agreed the captains/representatives shall meet on the morning of the game to inspect the ground and reach a decision on the fitness of the ground. If the two captains/representatives do not agree then both teams must turn up as normal.

- T30.11.2 Delayed start:

- In the event of a delayed start one over per side will be deducted for every full 6 minutes lost, up to a minimum of a 15 overs per side match. However, If both captains & umpires agree that prevailing weather conditions make it unlikely that a full 30 over game could be completed they may prior to the start of play agree to reduce the number of overs down to a minimum of 15 overs.

- T30.11.3 Interrupted game:

- Once the game has commenced stoppages in play shall not result in any deductions in the number of scheduled overs.

- The safety of all players and match officials is of paramount importance and we would expect that games would be abandoned with the agreement of both captains in the event of rain causing problems with recommended social distancing guidelines over a prolonged period of time. We recognise that facilities vary amongst our clubs but must insist that decisions are based upon the health and well being of players and officials.

- T30.12 THE RESULT:

- T30.12.1 The team making the higher score shall be the winners.

- T30.12.2 Where an interruption in play occurs during the second innings of a game, and it is subsequently not possible to compete the full scheduled number of overs,

- T30.12.2.1 should at least 50% of the allocated overs have been completed then the winning side shall be the one with the greater number of runs scored from the equivalent number of completed overs bowled at the point where the game is abandoned.

- T30.12.2.2 when less than 50% of the scheduled overs have been completed the tie shall be deemed abandoned and 2 points awarded to both teams.

T30 Specific Rules

- T30.13 UMPIRES EXPENSES:

T30.13.1 We recommend umpires receive a minimum of £20 expenses.

T30.13.2 Where no play is possible and the umpire has attended, we recommend a minimum of £10 expenses.

T30.13.3 Should a game be officiated by only one Club Umpire, the officiating Club Umpire shall receive an additional £20 expenses from the club failing to supply a Club Umpire.

T30.13.4 Clubs shall be responsible for the expenses paid to their own Club Umpire/s.

- T30.14 GROUP WINNERS:

The winners of each group shall receive £100
